

TEAM MEMBER ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The team lead plays a key role in the action phase, continuing as the point person for the donor and local stakeholders in planning follow-on activities. Actual implementation may be carried out by team members, or other local or international experts.

Team Lead

- Continue to serve as main point of contact with donor and local stakeholders.
- Work with donors and local stakeholders to develop and implement a technical assistance plan based on the prioritized recommendations.
- Identify subject matter experts (existing team members or beyond) to carry out technical assistance.

Team Coordinator

- Support planning and implementation of follow-on activities, as needed.
- Help identify experts to support follow-on activities.
- Assist with establishing a local office, if required.

Subject-Matter and Local Health Sector Experts

- Contribute to planning and implementation of follow-on activities, as appropriate.
